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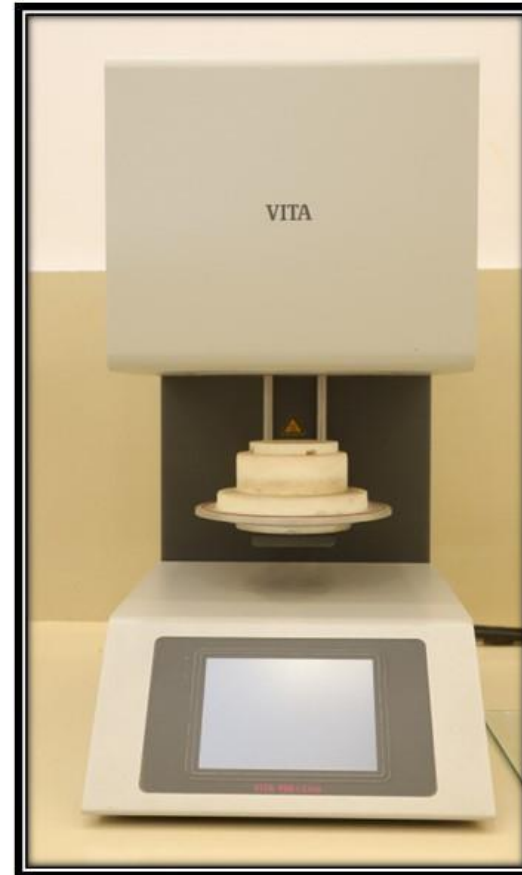

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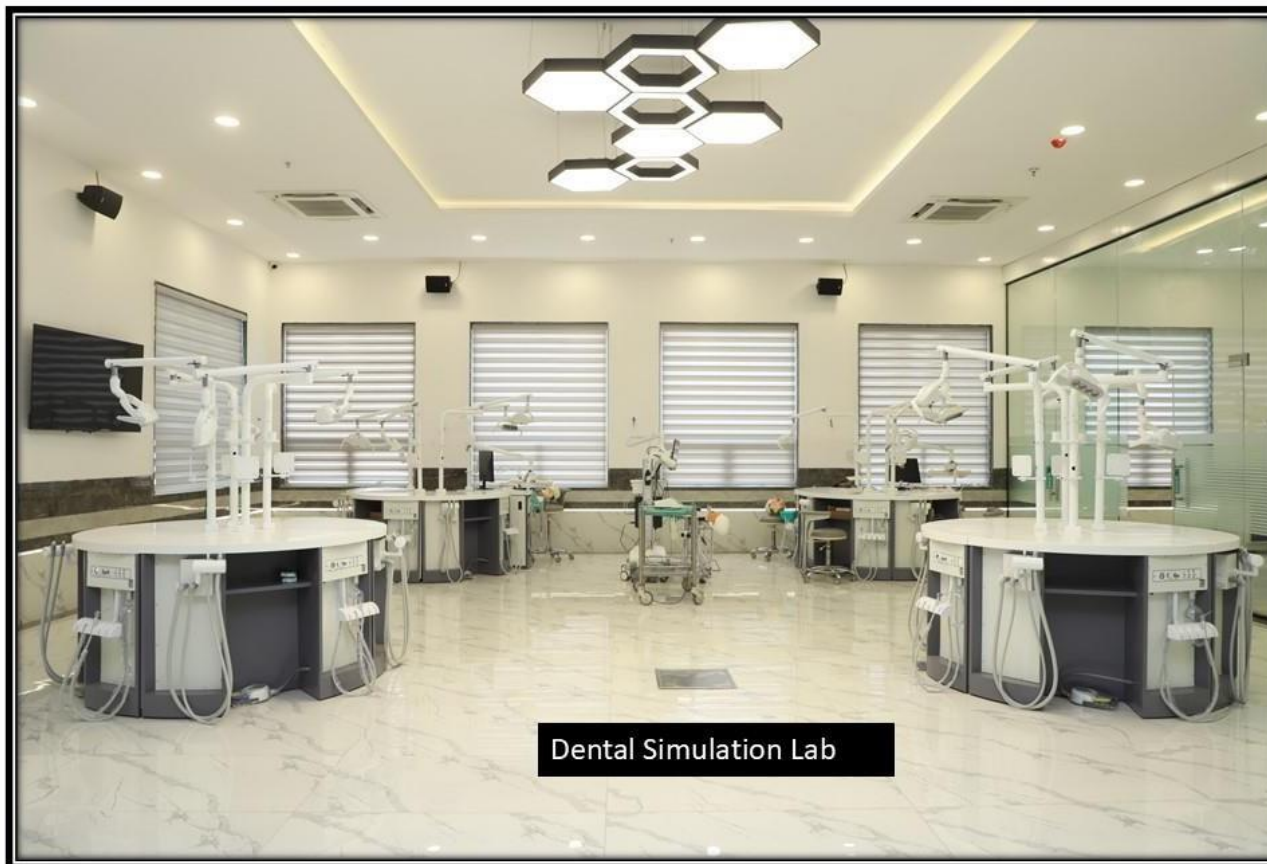

WHEREAS:

1. Federation of Special Care Dentistry (FSCD) is a society dealing exclusively with the oral health care of patients with special health care needs (SHCN) irrespective of their age .
2. GSL Dental College and Hospital, Rajahmundry (DPPD, GSLDCH) Federation of Special Care Dentistry (FSCD) is a society dealing exclusively with the oral health care of special children.
3. Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry, GSL Dental College and Hospital, Rajahmundry, is willing to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Federation of Special Care Dentistry (FSCD) for collaborative work such as research and the skills enhancement training program.

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OBJECTIVES

1. The objective of this MOU is to enable post graduate students of DPPD, GSLDCH to access to the activities of FSCD.
2. Period of MOU: This MOU shall come into force and effect from the date of execution and shall remain valid for a period of two year from such date after which the same may be reviewed by either party. However, if the same is not renewed this arrangement will be deemed terminated on the expiry of the said duration period.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF DPPD, GSLDCH

- 1.The Secretary General of FSCD, and DEAN/HOD DPPD, GSLDCH shall be responsible to work out operational details of cooperation between the two parties to ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 2.The DPPD, GSLDCH shall invite the Secretary General or any of the designated person of FSCD, annually to DPPD, GSLDCH to deliver a lecture.
- 3.The DPPD would be designated as nodal centre of FSCD in Rajmundry and all special children would be treated here.
- 4.It would be the responsibility of the DPPD, GSLDCH to ensure that proper publicity of the Program is made through DPPD, GDLCH website or other social media platforms.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF FSCD

1. FSCD would designate DPPD as nodal centre for Rajahmundry
2. FSCD would conduct at least one CDE / Conference in the duration of contract in the premises of GSLDCH as per the policy of the University
3. FSCD would provide subsidized rates for its conference / workshops to students of DPDD
4. Other Terms & Conditions:
 - 4.1The DPPD, GSLDCH shall not write/publish any material or use any logos/names of FSCD/ in any of the publications without prior written consent and approval from FSCD.
5. Commercials:
 - 5.1 FSCD would provide subsidized rates for its conference / workshops to students of DPDD
 - 5.2 The finances of delivering the lecture shall be done as per the university protocol of GSL EDUCATIONAL TRUST, Rajahmundry.
- 6.Limitations and Warranties:
 - 6.1Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MOU terms by the other party.

7. Termination:

7.1 Both parties can terminate the MOU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms or non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MOU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.

7.2 Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programs, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

8. Entirety & Amendment:

8.1 This MOU contains the entire understanding between the Parties in relation to the Training Program. If during the operation of the MOU, circumstances may rise which call for alteration / modification to this MOU, such alteration / modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MOU.

8.2 Any changes/amendments to this MOU not in conformance to this section shall be deemed to be void-ab-initio.

9. Intellectual Proprietary Rights

9.1 All intellectual or proprietary property and information, supplied or developed by either Party shall be and remain the sole and exclusive property of the Party who supplied or developed same. Upon termination of this MOU and upon written request, the Party in receipt of the requesting Party's intellectual or proprietary property and/or information pursuant to this MOU shall return such information to the requesting Party.

10. Confidential Information:

10.1. Both parties undertake to each other to keep confidential all information (written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of the other, which has been obtained or received during the course(s) of performance hereunder, save that which is inconsequential or obvious;

10.2. Already in its possession other than because of a breach of this clause; or in the hands of the public other than because of a breach of this clause.

10.3. In the event of any of the parties becoming legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such party shall give sufficient notice to the other party to enable the other party to seek a timely protective order or any other appropriate relief. If such an order or other relief cannot be obtained, the party being required to make such a disclosure shall make the disclosure of the Confidential Information only to the extent that is legally required of it and no further.

10.4. The DPPD, GSLDCH agrees not to deal directly or enter into any agreement, any clients of FSCD and should not share any information with them related to the training during the term of the agreement and after the agreement have been terminated, not earlier than two years from the date of termination.

11. Force Majeure:

11.1. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.

11.2. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.

12. Jurisdiction and Arbitration:

12.1 Any dispute arising out of, in relation to or in respect to this MOU shall be settled through mutual consultation and agreement, by the Parties to this MOU. In case a settlement is not arrived at within fifteen (15) days of reference, the dispute/s shall be referred to a sole arbitrator to be appointed in accordance to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. The place of arbitration shall be Jaipur, Rajasthan, India.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

By and between

And

GSL Dental College & Hospital,

A unit of GSL Educational Institutions

Rajahmundry, Andhra Pradesh

1) PREAMBLE:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by **ST.GREGORIOS DENTAL COLLEGE, Chelad, Kothamangalam, Ernakulam Dist, Kerala** and between **GSL Dental College & Hospital, GSL SMART LAB, A unit of GSL Educational Institutions Rajahmundry, Andhra Pradesh** are referred to collectively, as "Parties" or individually as "Party".

2) PURPOSE:

The Parties recognize the benefits to be desired from increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction for the further promotion and understanding in the field of dental education, research in dentistry, consultancy, scholarships and faculty development through various activities. (Here after collectively, referred to as "Field")

The purpose of this MOU is to define the areas of fundamental, academic research in which the parties desire to work together in the future for their mutual benefit to foster a collaborative framework between **ST.GREGORIOS DENTAL COLLEGE , Chelad, Kothamangalam, Ernakulam Dist, Kerala** and **GSL Dental College & Hospital, A unit of GSL Educational Institutions Rajahmundry, Andhra Pradesh** in the fields with the view to benefiting from each other's, strengths, initiatives and working procedures and to support collaboration among the researchers associated with both parties.

3) SCOPE:

This MOU sets forth the intentions of the parties for increased collaborations, cooperation and interaction and doesn't create any legally binding commitments, if the parties later agree to undertake, specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each party's contributions, deliverables and budgets.

Both parties agree to cooperate, subject to availability of funds and the respective approvals of both the institutions in academic activities and programs, research and consultancy activities and other areas of mutual interest including specifically the following:

- a) Exchange of students Post Graduate students
- b) Exchange of faculty or staff
- c) Joint research activities and publications.
- d) Participation in seminars and academic activities.
- e) Exchange of academic materials and other information
- f) Special short term academic programs.
- g) Specific training projects in the area of research and cooperate in clinical training
- h) Faculty development programs.
- i) Consultations services for curriculum development
- j) Other areas of interest and collaborations as shall be identified.

The terms of cooperation of each specific activity implemented under this MOU for Cooperation's shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both universities prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such MOUs entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this MOU for cooperation.

• STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

- The host College has the right to decide acceptance of exchange students, by taking account of recommendation issued from home College for exchange students based on their academic record.
- Transportation, accommodation, food clothing and other personal costs including the medical health insurance and medical care will be the personal responsibilities of the students themselves. However the host university may charge an amount for providing laboratory, library, internet facilities etc. the amount will be intimated at the time of making an offer.
- The host College shall reserve or make available accommodation on campus for exchange students or assist them in locating suitable housing off campus if they so desire.

- The exchange students will be subject to the student rules at the host College, while on exchange. Exchange students will be offered the same facilities as local students.
- Exchange students will study subjects or conduct researches which are pertinent to their field of study and are offered by the host College.
- Any intellectual property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Colleges

FACULTY EXCHANGE

The two Colleges will actively seek to promote mutual faculty exchange for mutual agreed periods.

- Faculty exchange may assume various forms, such as individual short-time and long term visit of facilities joint research and development projects.
- Both Colleges will try to seek external funding success to facilitate these exchanges.
- Encouragement of the academic faculty to co-author publications. Joint research activities and joint project possibilities is in subject to applicable copyright and/or other laws of each country, as well as rules and regulations of the respective universities.
- The host Colleges will endeavor to as much as possible, make available such facilities that will enable the faculty to obtain experience and training in its departments and institutes. Including the use of its laboratories and libraries.
- The two Colleges acknowledge that in the absence of an external funding agency, all expenses for travel, Living and allied cost will be left to the discretion and the responsibility of the home College
- Any intellectual property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Colleges.

4) COSTS:

Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MOU. Where possible and appropriate the Parties may also seek funding for collaborative activities from other agencies and institutions as appropriate.

5) INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION:

The treatment of intellectual property rights developed through collaborations under this MOU will be determined between the Parties through mutual consultation and separate written agreements to be entered on a case-by-case basis.

The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MOU. If either Party wishes to disclose information that it considers to be confidential or proprietary to the other person/institution, the Parties will enter into a written, Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement for each such requirement

TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING:

- a) This MOU will remain in force from the date of signature by both parties and shall continue in effect until either of the Parties expresses, in writing, to the other, a desire to terminate. Such termination shall have no effect on any outstanding obligations contractually agreed upon between the parties.
- b) The MOU may be terminated by either Party by giving one year's notice, in writing, to the other
- c) Any Amendment to the MOU will require the written approval of both Parties.
- d) Two signed originals of this MOU will be produced with one to reside with each Party.
- e) In the event that discrepancies arise between this document and any translation of it to a language other than English, this English version shall prevail.

8. Exchange of materials in education and research, academic publication and academic information has to be done in accordance with the prevailing institutions rules and regulations of the parties and within the legal framework of both countries.
9. This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years and may be continued thereafter after suitable review of the terms and conditions and by entering into a new MoU.
10. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither GSL Institutions nor UoP will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. 13. Unless otherwise stated, this MoU does not constitute or create, and will not be deemed to constitute any legally binding or enforceable obligations on the part of either institution unless and until an agreement regarding each objective is negotiated, approved, executed and delivered by the institutions.
14. This MoU represents the entire and integrated MoU between the parties and supersedes all the prior negotiations, representations, and agreements, whether written or oral.
15. The parties reserves the right for reasons of national security, national interest or public order to suspend temporarily, either in whole or in part, the implementation of this MoU, which suspension will take effect immediately after notification given to the other parties through diplomatic channels.
16. No parties shall be liable for any delay in performing, or for failure to perform, its obligations under this MOU, nor be liable to any claim for compensation or damage, nor be deemed to be in breach of this MOU to the extent that such delay, failure or

breach arises from any cause, event or circumstances beyond the reasonable control of that party (including acts of God, fire, flood, earthquake, natural catastrophe, storm, epidemic, war, terrorism, explosion, riot, civil disturbance or other national emergency, embargo, strike, lock-out or industrial dispute (involving employees other than its own), any acts or restraints of government or public authority, judicial orders or any breach or non-performance of this MOU by any other party provided the same arises without the fault or negligence of such party.

17. This MoU is signed after obtaining the approval of the respective academic/ administrative bodies.

OBJECTIVES

1. The objective of this MOU is to enable post graduate students of DPPD, GSLDCH to access to the activities of FSCD.
2. Period of MOU: This MOU shall come into force and effect from the date of execution and shall remain valid for a period of two year from such date after which the same may be reviewed by either party. However, if the same is not renewed this arrangement will be deemed terminated on the expiry of the said duration period.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF DPPD, GSLDCH

- 1.The Secretary General of FSCD, and DEAN/HOD DPPD, GSLDCH shall be responsible to work out operational details of cooperation between the two parties to ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 2.The DPPD, GSLDCH shall invite the Secretary General or any of the designated person of FSCD, annually to DPPD, GSLDCH to deliver a lecture.
- 3.The DPPD would be designated as nodal centre of FSCD in Rajmundry and all special children would be treated here.
- 4.It would be the responsibility of the DPPD, GSLDCH to ensure that proper publicity of the Program is made through DPPD, GDLCH website or other social media platforms.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES OF FSCD

1. FSCD would designate DPPD as nodal centre for Rajahmundry
2. FSCD would conduct at least one CDE / Conference in the duration of contract in the premises of GSL DCH as per the policy of the University
3. FSCD would provide subsidized rates for its conference / workshops to students of DPDD
4. Other Terms & Conditions:
 - 4.1The DPPD, GSLDCH shall not write/publish any material or use any logos/names of FSCD/ in any of the publications without prior written consent and approval from FSCD.
5. Commercials:
 - 5.1 FSCD would provide subsidized rates for its conference / workshops to students of DPDD
 - 5.2 The finances of delivering the lecture shall be done as per the university protocol of GSL EDUCATIONAL TRUST, Rajahmundry.
- 6.Limitations and Warranties:
 - 6 .1Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MOU terms by the other party.

7. Termination:

7.1 Both parties can terminate the MOU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms or non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MOU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.

7.2 Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programs, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

8. Entirety & Amendment:

8.1 This MOU contains the entire understanding between the Parties in relation to the Training Program. If during the operation of the MOU, circumstances may rise which call for alteration / modification to this MOU, such alteration / modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MOU.

8.2 Any changes/amendments to this MOU not in conformance to this section shall be deemed to be void-ab-initio.

9. Intellectual Proprietary Rights

9.1 All intellectual or proprietary property and information, supplied or developed by either Party shall be and remain the sole and exclusive property of the Party who supplied or developed same. Upon termination of this MOU and upon written request, the Party in receipt of the requesting Party's intellectual or proprietary property and/or information pursuant to this MOU shall return such information to the requesting Party.

10. Confidential Information:

10.1. Both parties undertake to each other to keep confidential all information (written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of the other, which has been obtained or received during the course(s) of performance hereunder, save that which is inconsequential or obvious;

10.2. Already in its possession other than because of a breach of this clause; or in the hands of the public other than because of a breach of this clause.

10.3. In the event of any of the parties becoming legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such party shall give sufficient notice to the other party to enable the other party to seek a timely protective order or any other appropriate relief. If such an order or other relief cannot be obtained, the party being required to make such a disclosure shall make the disclosure of the Confidential Information only to the extent that is legally required of it and no further.

10.4. The DPPD, GSLDCH agrees not to deal directly or enter into any agreement, any clients of FSCD and should not share any information with them related to the training during the term of the agreement and after the agreement have been terminated, not earlier than two years from the date of termination.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1) PREAMBLE:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by **ST.GREGORIOS DENTAL COLLEGE, Chelad, Kothamangalam, Ernakulam Dist, Kerala** and between **GSL Dental College & Hospital, GSL SMART LAB, A unit of GSL Educational Institutions Rajahmundry, Andhra Pradesh** are referred to collectively, as "Parties" or individually as "Party".

2) PURPOSE:

The Parties recognize the benefits to be desired from increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction for the further promotion and understanding in the field of dental education, research in dentistry, consultancy, scholarships and faculty development through various activities. (Here after collectively, referred to as "Field")

The purpose of this MOU is to define the areas of fundamental, academic research in which the parties desire to work together in the future for their mutual benefit to foster a collaborative framework between **ST.GREGORIOS DENTAL COLLEGE , Chelad, Kothamangalam, Ernakulam Dist, Kerala** and **GSL Dental College & Hospital, A unit of GSL Educational Institutions Rajahmundry, Andhra Pradesh** in the fields with the view to benefiting from each other's, strengths, initiatives and working procedures and to support collaboration among the researchers associated with both parties.

3) SCOPE:

This MOU sets forth the intentions of the parties for increased collaborations, cooperation and interaction and doesn't create any legally binding commitments, if the parties later agree to undertake, specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each party's contributions, deliverables and budgets.

Both parties agree to cooperate, subject to availability of funds and the respective approvals of both the institutions in academic activities and programs, research and consultancy activities and other areas of mutual interest including specifically the following:

- a) Exchange of students Post Graduate students
- b) Exchange of faculty or staff
- c) Joint research activities and publications.
- d) Participation in seminars and academic activities.
- e) Exchange of academic materials and other information
- f) Special short term academic programs.
- g) Specific training projects in the area of research and cooperate in clinical training
- h) Faculty development programs.
- i) Consultations services for curriculum development
- j) Other areas of interest and collaborations as shall be identified.

The terms of cooperation of each specific activity implemented under this MOU for Cooperation's shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both universities prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such MOUs entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this MOU for cooperation.

• STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

- The host College has the right to decide acceptance of exchange students, by taking account of recommendation issued from home College for exchange students based on their academic record.
- Transportation, accommodation, food clothing and other personal costs including the medical health insurance and medical care will be the personal responsibilities of the students themselves. However the host university may charge an amount for providing laboratory, library, internet facilities etc. the amount will be intimated at the time of making an offer.
- The host College shall reserve or make available accommodation on campus for exchange students or assist them in locating suitable housing off campus if they so desire.

- The exchange students will be subject to the student rules at the host College, while on exchange. Exchange students will be offered the same facilities as local students.
- Exchange students will study subjects or conduct researches which are pertinent to their field of study and are offered by the host College.
- Any intellectual property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Colleges

FACULTY EXCHANGE

The two Colleges will actively seek to promote mutual faculty exchange for mutual agreed periods.

- Faculty exchange may assume various forms, such as individual short-time and long term visit of facilities joint research and development projects.
- Both Colleges will try to seek external funding success to facilitate these exchanges.
- Encouragement of the academic faculty to co-author publications. Joint research activities and joint project possibilities is in subject to applicable copyright and/or other laws of each county, as well as rules and regulations of the respective universities.
- The host Colleges will endeavor to as much as possible, make available such facilities that will enable the faculty to obtain experience and training in its departments and institutes. Including the use of its laboratories and libraries.
- The two Colleges acknowledge that in the absence of an external funding agency, all expenses for travel. Living and allied cost will be left to the discretion and the responsibility of the home College
- Any intellectual property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Colleges.

4) COSTS:

Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MOU. Where possible and appropriate the Parties may also seek funding for collaborative activities from other agencies and institutions as appropriate.

5) INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION:

The treatment of intellectual property rights developed through collaborations under this MOU will be determined between the Parties through mutual consultation and separate written agreements to be entered on a case-by-case basis.

The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MOU. If either Party wishes to disclose information that it considers to be confidential or proprietary to the other person/institution, the Parties will enter into a written, Confidentiality and Non- Disclosure Agreement for each such requirement

TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING:

- a) This MOU will remain in force from the date of signature by both parties and shall continue in effect until either of the Parties expresses, in writing, to the other, a desire to terminate. Such termination shall have no effect on any outstanding obligations contractually agreed upon between the parties.
- b) The MOU may be terminated by either Party by giving one year's notice, in writing, to the other
- c) Any Amendment to the MOU will require the written approval of both Parties.
- d) Two signed originals of this MOU will be produced with one to reside with each Party.
- e) In the event that discrepancies arise between this document and any translation of it to a language other than English, this English version shall prevail.



8. Exchange of materials in education and research, academic publication and academic information has to be done in accordance with the prevailing institutions rules and regulations of the parties and within the legal framework of both countries.
9. This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years and may be continued thereafter after suitable review of the terms and conditions and by entering into a new MoU.
10. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither GSL Institutions nor UoP will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. 16. No parties shall be liable for any delay in performing, or for failure to perform, its obligations under this MOU, nor be liable to any claim for compensation or damage, nor be deemed to be in breach of this MOU to the extent that such delay, failure or


