Our institution has implemented objective methods to evaluate and certify the attainment of specific clinical competences by BDS students and interns, as mandated by the undergraduate curriculum established by the Dental Council of India (DCI). These methods ensure students acquire the professionalism, knowledge, and skills necessary to practice dentistry to the necessary standards. Objective Structured Clinical Examinations (OSCE) and Objective Structured Practical Examinations (OSPE) are used to assess the clinical and practical skills of students in a systematic and transparent manner. At many stations, certified examiners use standardized checklists to review predetermined tasks, such as patient diagnosis, treatment planning, and clinical procedure execution through **Learning Management System** and **Square One Exams** conducted by the institution for interns as well as third year students prior to entering into the clinical scenario. Furthermore, competency-based evaluations are conducted during internships, where students are required to demonstrate proficiency in certain clinical procedures. Consistent feedback is offered to students, accompanied by chances for remedial training to target specific areas needing improvement. The documentation of clinical activities, maintenance of logbooks, and regular assessments serve to closely track each student's progress. The certification of competencies is grounded in a thorough evaluation of theoretical understanding, clinical abilities, and professional conduct, in accordance with DCI's standards.
